



10 8 January 2012 - approximately 12:30am	The Respondent was stopped by police officers, Constables Newlands and Rounds, at Seaford for the purpose of a random breath test. The Respondent submitted to an alcotest using an apparatus approved under the <i>Road Traffic Act 1961 (SA) (RTA)</i> . The test indicated that the prescribed concentration of alcohol may then have been present.	Exhibit P3; Exhibit P9 at [5]; Exhibit P10; Exhibit P14
8 January 2012 - after 12:30am	The Respondent was conveyed to Christies Beach Police Station for the purpose of breath analysis testing.	Exhibit P9 at [6]
20 8 January 2012 - approximately 12:51 - 12:57am	The Respondent was directed to provide two samples of breath into an approved breath analysing instrument (serial number MRZEA012). The Respondent recorded results of 0.160 and 0.155 grams of alcohol in 210 litres of breath. The latter reading was recorded as the Respondent's blood alcohol reading at the time of driving. 8 January 2012 - approximately 1:01am	Constable Newlands provided oral advice found in Part A of Schedule 1 of the <i>Road Traffic (Miscellaneous) Regulations 1999 (SA) (the Regulations)</i> , required pursuant to s47K(2a) RTA in relation to blood testing. Constable Newlands provided a copy of Part B of Schedule 1 of the Regulations, pursuant to s47K(21) RTA to the Respondent.	Exhibit P3; Exhibit P9 at [8]; Exhibit P15; Exhibit P17
30 8 January 2012 - approximately 1:04 - 1:05am	The Respondent indicated he wanted a blood test kit. The Respondent signed a written request form and was provided with a sealed, approved blood test kit (serial number H012595).	Exhibit P3; Exhibit P4; Exhibit P9 at [8]; Exhibit P17
8 January 2012 - approximately 1:05am	The Respondent signed the Breath Analysis Statement completed by Constable Newlands.	Exhibit P3; Exhibit P17
8 January 2012 - approximately 1:10am	The Respondent declined to answer any questions in relation to the matter. Constable Newlands issued the Respondent with a Notice of Licence Disqualification for his an immediate loss of licence (disqualification number I1955845). 8 January 2012 – after 1:10am	Police drove the Respondent to the Noarlunga Hospital - Accident and Emergency Department for the purpose of a blood test.	Exhibit P9 at [10]
8 January 2012 - between 1:18 and 2:24am <i>[note Respondent says blood taken at 2:45am – Tx31]</i>	The Respondent presented to the Noarlunga Hospital and was examined by Dr Klima. Dr Klima took one sample of blood from the Respondent and divided it in two, giving one to the Respondent and putting one aside for collection by Police.	Exhibit P19; Trial TX P7, L20
13 January 2012	A sample of blood marked H012595 was received by the Forensic Science Centre in Adelaide. This sample was examined by Dr Mason for the presence of alcohol. The sample was denatured and unsuitable for analysis of alcohol.	Exhibit P13; Exhibit P16
16 August 2012	The Respondent provided a sample of blood marked H012595 to the Forensic Science Centre in Adelaide for analysis. This sample of blood was examined by Dr Traljic for the presence of alcohol. The sample was denatured and unsuitable for analysis of alcohol.	Exhibit P16; Trial TX, P32, L9
1 November 2012; 26 July 2013	Trial in the Magistrates Court of South Australia.	Certificate of Record
