

18 January 2016	Queensland Nickel Pty Ltd (the <b>Company</b> ) entered into voluntary administration pursuant to s 436A of the <i>Corporations Act 2001(Cth)</i> ( <b>Corporations Act</b> )	Affidavit of Clive Frederick Palmer affirmed in the Palmer Proceedings on 19.9.16 at [23].
22 April 2016	The creditors of the Company resolved pursuant to s 439C(c) of the Corporations Act that the Company be voluntarily be wound up. The administrators were appointed as liquidators of the Company.	Affidavit of Clive Frederick Palmer affirmed in the Palmer Proceedings on 19.9.16 at [24].
18 May 2016	On the application of the Commonwealth and the Commissioner of Taxation in their capacities as creditors of the Company, the federal Court (Dowsett J) made an order pursuant to s 511 and 472(1) of the Corporations Act appointing the defendants	Exhibit CP-01 of the affidavit of Clive Frederick Palmer affirmed in the Palmer Proceedings on 19.9.16.

19 August 2016	The plaintiff was served with a summons, which had been issued by the Federal Court (Registrar Belcher), summoning the plaintiff for examination. The summons required the plaintiff to attend before the Federal Court to be examined on oath about the examinable affairs of the Company and to produce at the examination specified books in the plaintiff’s possession, custody or under the plaintiff’s control.
